SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS:

1. Submit this completed application form as page 1 along with your project proposal.
2. Include on each page of proposal: project title, your full name & page number.
3. Clearly state, in 150-300 words, the purpose of the project, budget and description.
4. Include all other sources of funding, and state the total dollar amount you are requesting.
5. If you are requesting funding to attend a virtual conference, provide the conference name and dates of attendance, and the purpose of attending. If you are presenting a paper at the conference, provide acceptance notice, paper title and description.
6. If you are requesting research materials, submit an itemized list with pricing and justification for purchase if freely available at library or online.
7. Submit your request as one document in PDF format via email to Judaic@brown.edu with subject line: "Judaic Studies research award submission".
